The overall goal is to enhance the quality of life for some of the most at-risk populations. Volunteer Ombudsman receive special training and ongoing professional support, can plan their own schedules, and are permitted to visit their assigned nursing home any day of the week to best work around their schedule. If you are a retired professional, or other capable and well-motivated individual, and are interested in the well-being and protection of residents receiving long-term care services, we would love to hear from you.

Currently, we have six active volunteers throughout our ten-county district who do a wonderful job advocating for long-term care residents and those receiving long-term care services. Just last year in 2024, our volunteer group achieved some outstanding numbers with volunteering, including:

- 612 volunteer hours (up 28% from the previous year)
- 3,434 individuals reached (up 28% from the previous year)
