## **AAA7 to Host Senior Health Event at Bossard Library**

The Area Agency on Aging District 7 (AAA7) is working with local partners to host a special health event for older adults on Thursday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> from 2:00 pm until 4:00 pm at Bossard Memorial Library in Gallipolis, located at 7 Spruce Street.

Featured at the free event will be flu and COVID-19 vaccinations, health screenings, a falls prevention exercise demonstration (one at 2:00 pm and one at 3:00 pm), a free take-home Spring craft (while supplies last), resource information from participating partners, and refreshments. A special gift card incentive will be presented to adults who receive either the flu or COVID-19 vaccine, while supplies last.

The event is hosted by the Area Agency on Aging District 7, Bossard Memorial Library, and the Gallia County Health Department.
