



# AAA7 Vaccine Update

## 5/11/2022

This update includes upcoming scheduled vaccine opportunities in our ten core counties.

### **Primary Plus (Brown County)**

- The CDC has authorized a 2<sup>nd</sup> booster for patients 50 years old and older who have been at least 4 months from their first booster. PrimaryPlus offices are following CDC recommendations and are now offering the 2<sup>nd</sup> booster. You can contact your local PrimaryPlus office to schedule an appointment - (606) 956-0220

### **Holzer Health System**

- Appointments for a second booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine are now available. Call 740-446-5566 for an appointment.
- Individuals are eligible to receive the second booster dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines if it has been at least 4 months since receiving the first booster dose and meet one of the following criteria: 50+ years of age; 18+ years of age who are immunocompromised; or 12-17 years of age who are immunocompromised (Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine only).

### **Jackson County Health Department**

- Now providing a second booster dose of COVID-19 vaccines to the following groups of individuals:
  - People ages 12 years and older who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may choose to receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least four months after the first booster dose.
  - Adults ages 50 years and older who are not moderately or severely immunocompromised may choose to receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least four months after the first booster dose.
  - People ages 18-49 who are not moderately or severely immunocompromised and who received Janssen COVID-19 vaccine as both their primary series dose and booster dose may receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least four months after the first Janssen booster dose.

### **Lawrence County Health Department**

Offering COVID-19 Vaccines:

Pediatric Pfizer (for 5-11 year-olds), Pfizer (for 12 and over), Moderna (18 and over) and Johnson and Johnson (18 and over). Boosters available for those 12 years of age and older who are eligible. If you are coming for a second dose or a boost dose, please bring your vaccine card with you.

- Wednesday 5/11/22 from 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm at the South Point Board of Education, 302 High Street in South Point.
- Thursday 5/12/22 from Noon until 5:00 pm at the Lawrence County Health Department, 2122 So. 8<sup>th</sup> Street in Ironton.

### **Pike County Health District**

- We are now offering a second booster dose of COVID vaccines to the following groups of individuals:
  - Adults who are 50 years of age and older may choose to receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least four months after their first booster dose.
  - Individuals who are 12 years of age and older who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may choose to receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least four months after their first booster dose.
  - Individuals who are between 18-49 years old who received Janssen COVID-19 vaccine as both their primary series dose and booster dose may receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least four months after their first Janssen booster dose (Johnson & Johnson).

### **Scioto County Health Department**

- Administering the second COVID-19 booster to those 50 and over who have received the first booster at least four months prior. Please bring your ID, insurance card and vaccination card. No appointment necessary.
- COVID Clinic Hours: Tuesday – Thursday 9:00 am until 12 Noon and 1:00 pm until 3:00 pm. Friday from 9:00 am until 12 Noon. Located in the Courthouse Annex – 612 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite D, Portsmouth (in the basement).
- Eligibility requirements included on the Health Department’s Facebook post from April 4<sup>th</sup>.

### **Vinton County Health Department**
